

Producing torque at low rpm without compromising power output is the tricky part of the equation, but its benefits in driveability are readily noticeable, with easier over-taking, less gear-changing and imtiming and duration and fuel timing and flow to match the engine condition and the demands being made upon it. And it can do all of this as often as 400 times a second.

cam, maintenance-free hydraulic tappets and electronic ignition, their routine servicing needs are small, and their blend of power, performance and economy makes them superb all-rounders.

New 1.8i and 2.0i

For all that, the introduction of two brand-new engines for 1987-1.8i and 2.0i-is clearly one piece of news to grab the attention of Cavalier enthusiasts – fast.

Developed from the established Family Two units on which Cavalier's reputation is forged, these are so extensively different that they can effectively be regarded as brand new. So while you'll still find that familiar Cavalier verve, you'll also be surprised by a new smoothness, satisfied by a little extra crispness and impressed by new levels of economy.

Right from the early stages the new engine programme targeted a number of very specific areas for improvement. The engineers wanted to boost torque and therefore performance by reaching peak levels at lower revs.

In addition, they aimed to ensure excellent performance on the lower-octane, lead-free fuels. With that in mind, the new 1.8i and 2.0i now have a simple under-bonnet switch which allows the driver to change to 95-octane fuel in seconds.


Low End Torque has long been a prime objective of GM engine designers. proved fuel consumption. As part of the huge engine development programme, two completely new 2.0i power units are added to Cavalier choice, one for the CD and the other, available in the spring of 1987, for SRi models.

The CD engine is torque-optimised for economy and smoothness, while the SRi unit is performance-oriented.

Their arrival also marks the introduction of another development completely new to the Vauxhall-Opel range – Bosch Motronic engine management.

Both 2.0i Cavaliers feature Bosch ML4 Motronic as standard. This digital microcomputer system controls the operation of electronic multipoint fuel injection and breakerless electronic ignition from one central 'brain'.

The use of electronic ignition and electronic fuel injection is widely accepted, and the advantages of serviceability and long-term accuracy are established and appreciated. Bosch LE Jetronic fuel injection is indeed one feature which has contributed much to Cavalier's performance. The Motronic system is a logical extension of these two features. Instead of dealing with them separately, their functions are combined. The control unit compares all the data received from each of its sensors with its preprogrammed memory. Based on these comparisons, it then adjusts spark



Other considerations aside, it is a great deal more efficient than conventional fuel/ignition systems. The

computer controls fuel cutoff on over-run, for example, and it sets a stable 750rpm idle speed regardless of engine or ambient temperature.

Motronic package also includes a simple self-diagnostic programme which allows a Service Technician to effect repairs easily. And it has a preprogrammed set of average values which enable it to continue operating in case of a system failure – so if one of its sensors fails it won't just stop by the roadside.

Like the 1.8i engine, it can easily be switched between high or lead-free low-octane fuel.

Even at first glance, the new Cavaliers are as distinctively different inside as out. New cloth trims for each model are first to catch the eye, and there are new luxury see-through head restraints for most models. All except the Convertible now have height-adjustable front seat belts and rear seat belts are standard in all models. As befits the top-of-the-range model, the CD introduces Chain Velour, completely new to the Vauxhall range.


Every step of the way the aim has been to improve the already-high quality of Cavalier motoring, to add comfort, convenience and extra quality to one of Britain's favourite cars.


Cavalier L models have a reputation as extremely well-equipped cars, and that's going to get quite a boost during 1987. New Mosaic velour trim, seethrough front seat head restraints, five-speed gearbox and tinted glass are the highlights of its new interior. Detail touches to door pockets and retractable load cover for estate are just some of the things which confirm the Cavalier L as one of Britain's favourite cars.

The DC 751 and DC 842 incorporate a highly sophisticated and effective anti-theft deterrent which provides excellent security yet is simple in operation.


This Security Code system does not prevent theft of the unit, but simply makes it a pointless exercise by defeating the object. Unless the correct security code number is entered the radio will not operate, and thus has no practical or resale value.

Using the radio section's pre-set tuning buttons a 3-digit code is stored in the unit's memory. This code can be any combination of three digits, chosen at random by the owner personally, making the list of possible permutations large enough to defeat simple guesswork.

Once this code is programmed

it remains 'locked' in the memory. If at any time the unit is removed from the facia or disconnected from the battery it will not function until the correct code number is re-entered.

If an attempt is made to enter an incorrect code not only will the unit not function, but after three incorrect attempts have been made a waiting period of two hours must elapse before it will accept another entry. The PSC symbol and its significance will be widely publicised to identify radios with this new feature. Additionally, stickers identifying it will be supplied with relevant vehicles.
