Working closely with Vauxhall-Opel, Robert Jankel Design have based the Cavalier Convertible on a 2-door Cavalier with a 1600 engine and a superb trim level adapted from the Cavalier GLS specification.

Then they've added some extra special touches, such as Cavalier SR wheels and a special display finish in triple-coat pearlised white paintwork.

The easily-operated hood is in luxurious, waterproof mohair. It folds neatly into a hood bag. The car's door windows wind down fully and the two rear side screens are removable to give a completely 'open' feel. When raised, the hood naturally provides complete weather protection. Even with its sleek profile, it gives generous headroom.

The exceptionally large rear screen is of 'Vy-back'. This is a strong material that can ward off the extremes of British weather.

And, being a Cavalier, this convertible has the pace to go with the style. It seats up to five and has a really big boot. So it's practical in every way.
